Re-use/Donations FAQs

I hear a lot about re-use. What kind of items can I donate for re-use in your re-sale store? We appreciate clean re-usable donations of household items, hardware, rebuilding materials. Please bring all clean re-usable items to the attendant at the donations building. Look for the large sign that says Donate Here.

How can I tell if something is trash rather than something that can be reused? Dirty, stained, broken, moldy, or smelly items may be accepted at the trash rate. Please sort trash items from re-use donation items.

Are my donations tax deductible? CARTM is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization. Your donations are tax deductible. We provide you with a donation receipt and you fill in the value. We do not assign value to your items.

Is there a certain time of day to bring my re-use donations? Please bring donations as early as possible during open hours. We prefer to receive large loads no later than 3 p.m.

What if there is hardware or electrical cords missing from my re-use donation? Please bring all hardware and electrical cords for your items. It is difficult to re-sell items that are incomplete.

I'm unsure if all of my electronics can be donated for re-use? Please donate all of your used electronics, working or not. We test all televisions, computers, printers, answering machines and telephones before putting them in the store for resale. If they cannot be sold, we recycle them. Electronics are prohibited in the trash.

What departments are housed in your re-sale store? Household items, furniture, appliances, hardware, tools, electrical, plumbing, electronics, decorative, kitchen, books, sporting goods, textiles and linens and building materials.

Does CARTM accept clean re-usable clothing? We do not accept clothing at this time and recommend that you take your clean, re-usable clothing to the Hope Chest on Hwy 101 between Nehalem and Manzanita.

What are the items CARTM does not accept for resale?

- We do not accept anything deemed unsafe.
- Baby car seats, strollers, cribs or related equipment for babies.
- Mattresses that do not meet flammability requirements.
- Fluorescent bulbs and lighting fixtures with ballasts
- Wood stoves without certification
- Asbestos containing materials
- Household hazardous waste which would include:
liquids of any sort, cleaning supplies, personal care products, solvents, chemicals etc.
- Fireworks, ammunition, firearms, explosives
